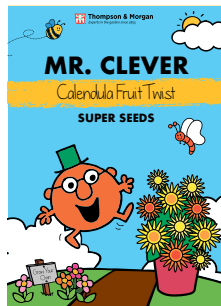

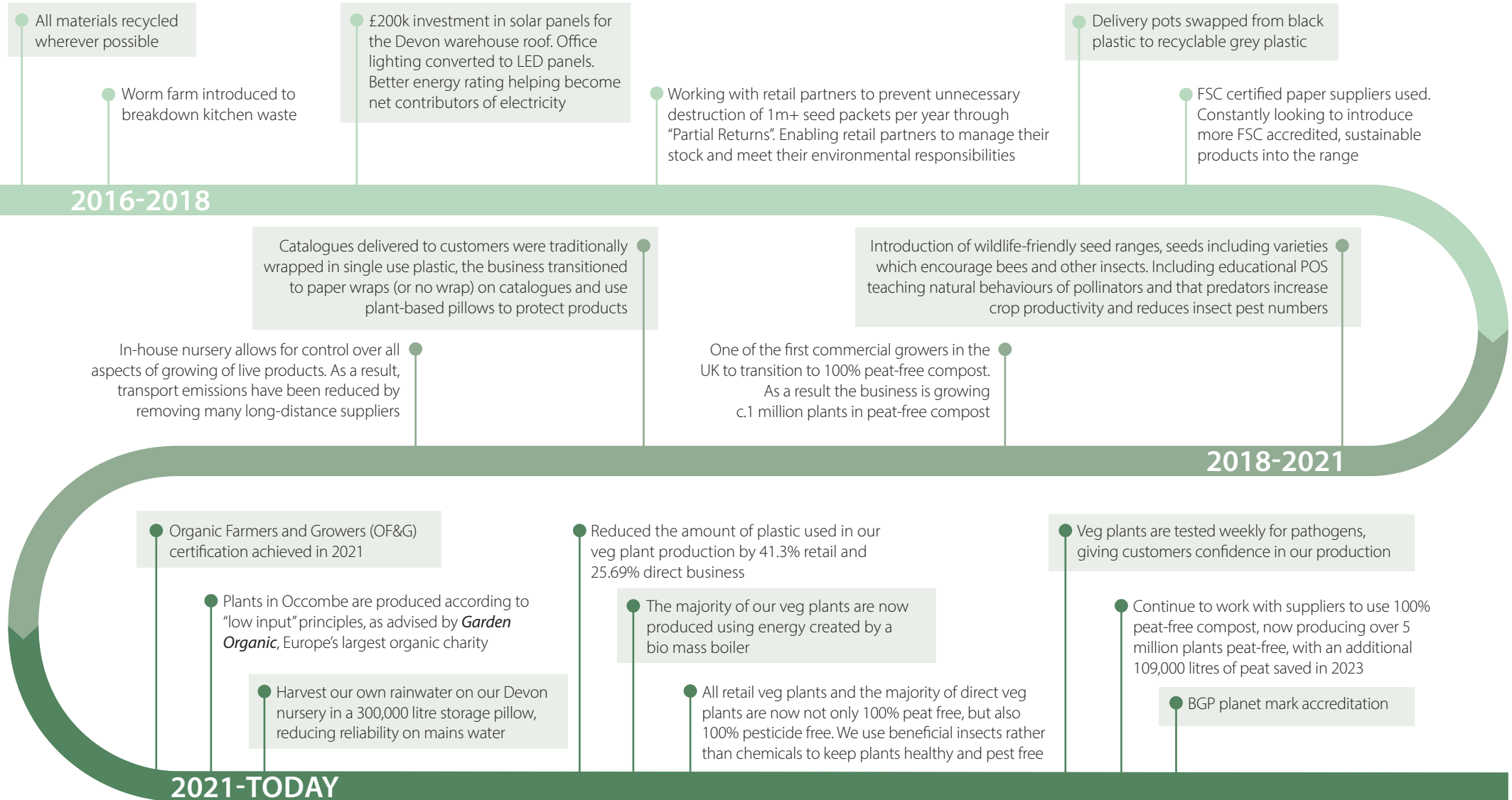

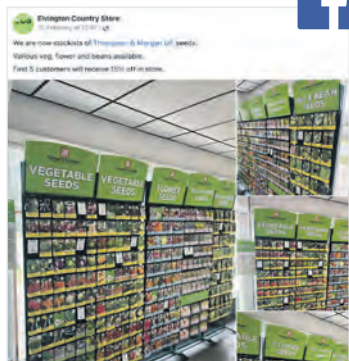

Producing large flowers on small plants with no need to dead-head! A perfect cross of African and French Marigolds brings the absolute best of both worlds. Extra large double flowers (up to 9cm across) on a compact French Marigold.

SOWING INSTRUCTIONS: Fill a seed tray with good, free-draining, damp, seed compost. Sow seed on the surface of the compost and cover with a very fine sprinkling of dry vermiculite or finely sieved compost. Place the seed and tray in a propagator or seal inside a polythene bag and keep at around 21-25°C (70-75°F) until the seeds germinate. This will take about 7-21 days. Don't exclude light as this helps germination.

GROWING INSTRUCTIONS: When the seedlings are large enough to handle, transplant them individually into 7.5cm (3in) pots or multi-cell trays. Before planting out, acclimatise the plants to cooler conditions by putting them outside for a few hours a day for a few weeks. Plant out when all risk of frost has passed, about 30cm (12in) apart.

Shimmer F1 (Plum)

Shimmer F1 is a unique coloured tomato with red, green and gold stripes. Almost shaped fruit, bigger than a cherry type but smaller than a Roma tomato. The fruit are great for snacking and they also add a splash of colour to salads. Resistance to late blight.

Our grafted tomatoes are selected for, and best suited to, greenhouse growing but will also thrive outdoors in most summers. They are ready for planting in their final positions, late April-May in the greenhouse (some heat may be necessary initially), or late May-June outside (when danger of frost has passed). The root systems of these plants have great vigour and should be given plenty of room to grow. When planting always ensure that the graft 'union' is kept above the soil level. If they are to be grown indoors, use a deep pot no smaller than 30cm (12"). Alternatively, they can be planted direct into the greenhouse soil (note that most grow bags are unlikely to provide the root space required for best results).

If growing outside, plant 60cm (2') apart and provide support with canes. Once fruit appear, feed twice a week with tomato fertiliser and remove side-shoots from leaf joints.

Please note: With regards to the nature of the blight resistance, plants can still show infection (up to 10-15%) of leaves, stems etc. without effecting fruit quality or yield. The plants having the resistance to be able to grow away from the attack.

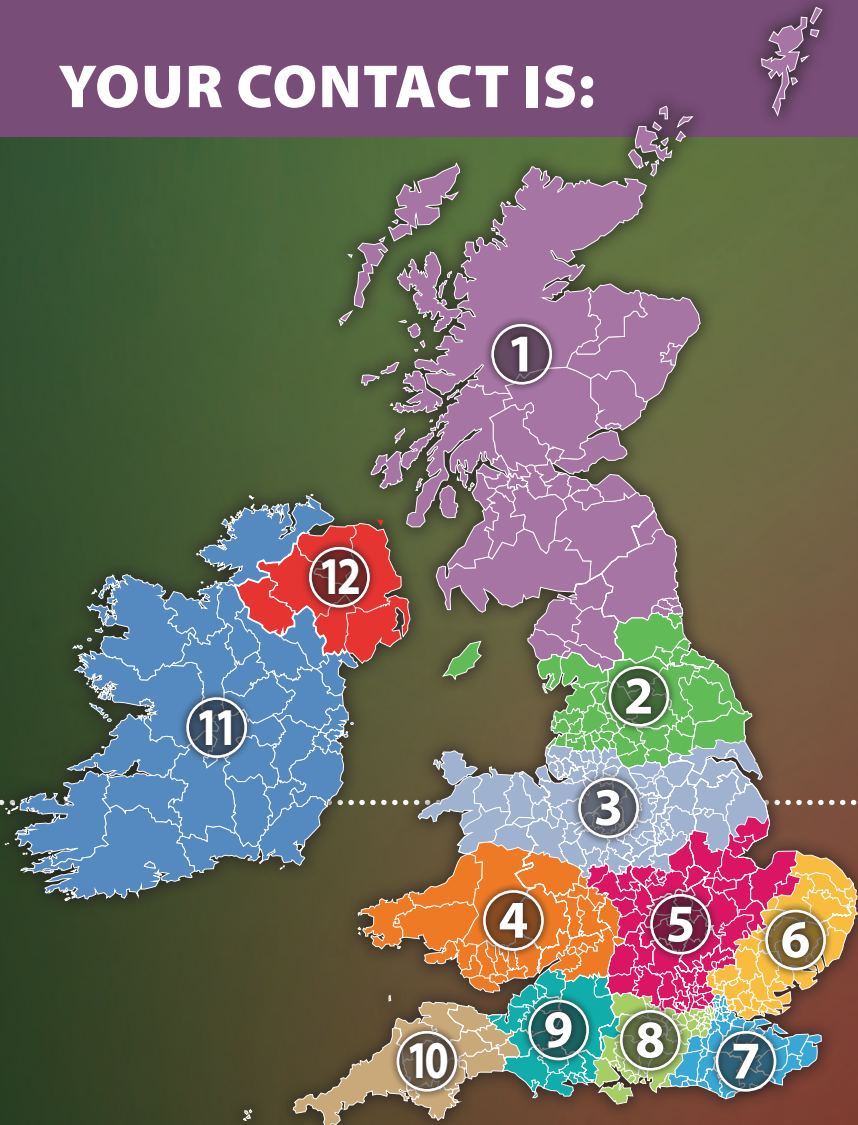
